Dear Parent/Caregiver,

Charles Campbell College's Year 7 camp will be held at Mylor Adventure Camp. The Camp will be an adventure-based learning program concentrating on team building, under the direct supervision of College staff and the camp's specially trained instructors. The program may include adventure activities such as Flying Fox, Giant Swing, Bridge Building, Bouldering, Low Ropes, Raft Making, Challenge Course and Initiative Pursuits.

Year 7's will be attending camp in Week 10 of Term 2, for three days and two nights from Wednesday 3 July 2024 to Friday 5 July 2024. We will depart Charles Campbell College at 9:30am on Wednesday and return to school by 2:20pm on Friday.

The total cost of the camp is \$330; a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit must be paid by Friday 12 April 2024 (Week 11, Term 1). Final payments are due by Friday 14 June 2024 (Week 7, Term 2).
