ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING UPDATE

Continuous Reporting for all students in Years 7-12

Friday 12 April 2024

Dear Families,

Traditionally, schools communicated students' achievements to students and families via an end of term report.

At the beginning of 2024, we introduced continuous reporting of student academic achievements and behaviours for learning. You may have noticed changes to Daymap.

Continuous reporting in Daymap includes:

- feedback on all assessed pieces of student work
- judgements about each student's behaviours for learning via traffic lights, which are updated in Week 6 of each term and valid for four weeks
- an overall grade indicator for each subject, which is updated automatically as new assessments are recorded by teachers
- the overall grade indicator is continuously updated using the grades awarded for each completed assessment task
- the individual grades for completed assessment tasks can be viewed by clicking the overall grade indicator

Continuous reporting is an innovation that empowers families to meaningfully engage in their child's learning.

Academic Statement

On Monday 15 April, families will be able to download their child's Academic Statement from Daymap. The Academic Statement takes a snapshot at the end of each term and records:

- The student's overall attendance
- The results of all graded summative assessments for their subjects studied

The Academic Statement will be produced at the end of every term and replaces the Term Report. We will add additional features to subsequent Academic Statements over the course of this year.
