Personalised Comprehensive Reports: Reception to Year 6 students

Dear Families,

Reporting about students' achievements in Reception to Year 6 can occur in many ways. In Reception to Year 6 we know that:

- teachers make regular calls to families highlighting positive achievements and / or areas of concerns
- Reception to Year 4 families use SeeSaw to stay in touch
- Daymap is used only by students, families and teachers in Years 5 and 6, but only to a limited extent
- teachers and families use email to connect

Traditionally, at the end of each term the College produced a brief written report for families with children in Reception* to Year 6.

At the beginning of 2024, we introduced improvements to our reports, which will now be produced each semester at the end of Terms 2 and 4. The format of the report will be similar to the attached R-6 report sample.

Our new reports will:

- include assessments of the student's social learning
- record the student's attendance and punctuality
- include assessments of learning in all eight Learning Areas against the achievement standards
- have personal comments about the students written by their classroom teacher
