The Certificate II in Retail Cosmetics (SHB20116) is the entry level qualification for the makeup industry. You will learn a range of skills including applying makeup, recommending and selling products, social media skills and visual merchandising.

This course has been designed for those wanting to develop the skills and knowledge to sell, demonstrate and apply cosmetic products to an industry standard.

Successful students will graduate with a nationally recognised qualification which can be used to seek employment as a Makeup Artist or work in a cosmetic retail environment.

For VET in School students, the successful completion of the following units of competency is recognised towards 60 SACE Credits. If students decide to continue studies after gaining this qualification, some units may be available for credit transfer.
