COURSE SUMMARY

The Pathway to Hair and Makeup is available for students who are interested in exploring a hairdressing or makeup career.

The short course provides graduates with basic hairdressing and makeup development skills, an understanding of in-salon communication and health and safety and will provide attendees with an understanding of whether they would like to continue studies in hairdressing or makeup.

The included units are at a Level II and on completion; students will receive up to 10 SACE Credits for Stage 1.

If students decide to continue studies after completion of this short course, some units may be available for credit transfer or recognised prior learning for Certificate II in Retail Cosmetics (SHB20116), Certificate II in Salon Assistant (SHB20216) or Certificate III in Hairdressing (SHB30416) via School Based Apprenticeship (SBA).
