

**RE: YEAR 12 SUPERVISED STUDY**

Dear parent/caregiver,

We recognise the direct correlation between effective study routines and quality results. As Year 12s, your child's results this year have the strongest potential to shape options for post-school transition.

One of the challenges students face to developing a good study routine is their ability to manage their time. Though many students are able to do this, some need further support. As an initial strategy, the College has created a daily Study line between recess and lunch. This has been added to your child's timetable on DayMap. Attendance to this supervised class is compulsory for students who have contact times at the start of the day.

**How does this impact my child's timetable/contact hours?**

Students that begin in Lessons 1 or 2 will remain until their final lesson or until the conclusion of Study in Lesson 4. Students who begin their learning mid- or at the end of day, are invited to attend Study for any non-contact Lesson (3 and/or 4).

**Is this addition permanent?**

At the end of Term 1, students that achieve results above a 'C' in each subject will have the option of removing the Study line. Students who achieve results at a 'C-' or below in one or more subjects will be required to continue attending supervised study.

Additional reviews of performance via mid-term 'traffic lights' and end-of-term grades will inform us as to whether your child will be required to continue or be reinstated to attend the Study line for learning support.
